For unacceptable behaviors we will use progressive discipline, which includes thinking time, parental involvement, and possible dismissal. Please review this list with your child(ren) prior to attending our program. Our leaders will also review each item with all participants. 1. *Stop, look and listen for instructions when you hear our clap or whistle.*
2. Please be **courteous** to camp counselors and other campers:
 - a. Give to others in need.
 - b. Share with others.
 - c. Think of others before yourself.
3. Please be **responsible**:
 - a. Clean up any mess you have created.
 - b. Tell a counselor when going to the restroom.
4. Please **respect** yourself and others.
 - a. Honor other's opinions, beliefs, and needs.
 - b. Be considerate and polite to camp counselors and other campers.
 - c. Take care of the environment.
 - d. Take care of personal property and public property.
 - e. Obey camp counselors.
5. Please **cooperate** with counselors and other campers
 - a. Stop, look, and listen for the camp clap or whistle.
 - b. Let everyone have a turn.
 - c. Share with others.
6. Please be **honest** to camp counselors and others.
 - a. Speak the truth.
 - b. Keep your promises.
 - c. Be sincere in your actions and words.
 - d. Do what you know is right.

Behaviors that are Unacceptable at Stuff 2-Do:

1. Yelling or screaming at counselors, other campers, or people not in our group.
2. Harmful physical contact with counselors, other campers, or people not in our group.
 - a. Pushing or shoving.
 - b. Hitting in any way or kicking.
 - c. Biting or scratching.
 - d. Throwing an unsafe object at someone.
3. Using unacceptable language.
 - a. Cuss words in any form.
 - b. Name calling in any form.
4. Leaving the group at any time without permission.
5. Destruction of property/environment:
 - a. MUD property.
 - b. Harming plants or trees, or littering.
 - c. Campers' property.
